MINIMUM STORAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORY H

ALL handgun(s) must be stored in a steel safe which:

Is of a thickness that is not easily penetrable (minimum 5mm).

If it weighs less than 150 kilograms when empty, must be bolted to the structure of the premises.

Is locked when any firearms are stored in it.

MINIMUM SAFE SPECIFICATIONS

A safe with the following specifications:

- (i) Not less than 5mm mild steel plate, welded construction suitably reinforced.
- (ii) Not readily portable, it must be adequately secured to a structure or object, which is not readily portable.
- (iii) The security of the safe shall not be dependent on external hinges or lock(s).
